39 ChatGPT, History, Users, and its Uses</h2>

41 ChatGPT is an AI created by OpenAI that has been trained to be able to
42 interact with it's user
43 </br>
44 in a way that makes it seem more conversational. It is able to help it's
45 user with tasks such
46 </br>
47 as correcting essays, helping write emails, or fixing code errors. It was
48 released on
49 </br>
50 November 30, 2022 and is a more advanced version of InstructGPT, another AI
51 created by the
52 </br>
53 company at an earlier time. ChatGPT was trained off of something called RHLF
54 which stands for
55 </br>
56 Reinforcement Learning from Human Feedback. This is what makes ChatGPT able
57 to communicate
58 </br>
59 with its user in a more natural way as well as allowing it to be able to
60 answer follow up
61 </br>
62 questions. "AI trainers" used this method to be able to instill the
63 intelligence in this AI
64 </br>
65 The programmers would use "model conversations" in which they would write
66 for both parts, as the

58 consumer and the AI itself. ChatGPT is able to be used to answer any simple
questions as well
59 </br>
60 as draft full articles for its user. This platform, after going viral on
the internet has had
61 </br>
62 over 100 million users. The creator of ChatGPT, OpenAI, was founded in 2015
by Elon Musk and
63 </br>
64 a group of others. In 2016, OpenAI was gathering many AI researchers coming
to work for them,
65 </br>
66 even as the starting salary wasn't anywhere near where it is today. The
company created
67 </br>
68 something called the "Universe" that year which allowed to help train AI's
intelligence.
69 </br>
70 In 2018, the company developed the idea of GPTs which were able to function
similar to the human
71 </br>
72 brain. Over the years, they would develop this idea further until in
December of 2022, ChatGPT
73 </br>
74 was released to the public. This release is predicted to make the company a
projected
75 </br>
76 \$200 million in 2023 and \$1 billion in 2024.

86 Although ChatGPT is arguably the best public AI available currently, it does
still have its limits.
87 </br>
88 This can include the device being unable to understand certain wordings
which can force the user
89 </br>
90 to reword their questions. It also is very limited to what it can say as
the free version is unable
91 </br>
92 to use the information from the internet. ChatGPT was designed and trained
on information from its
93 </br>
94 programmers and tester which makes it limited in how much knowledge in
different fields it has access
95 </br>
96 to. Unfortunately, ChatGPT can often deliver incorrect answers so although
they look professional,
97 </br>
98 they are not always correct. We can see that although the AI's abilities can
seem limitless, there
99 </br>
100 are often topics that it is simply unable to help with. This demonstrates
AI's power as of now as
101 </br>
102 we can see that it is only able to harness whatever information has been
given to it and is unable to
103 </br>
104 yet learn on its own to a permanent extent. The use of ChatGPT is often

107 known to be used by many students to do their assignments for them which is
108 unethical and can be

110 considered cheating. However it is harder to determine what has been
111 created originally rather than

113 what has been made by the AI. Others however may argue that ChatGPT is
114 completely fine as it is really

116 directed to the people who will use it in the right ways. Some advantages of
117 using ChatGPT as opposed to

119 other AIs is that it is able to respond using more casual context making it
120 seem almost human like along

122 with its faster response times. Some cons however is that it is limited to
123 certain data and that because

125 of this, soem responses may have bias based on the information it was

133 Keeping ChatGPT Safe and Where and How it can be Used</h2>

136 ChatGPT can often be misused to get answers to homework questions because
137 the student does not want to
138 </br>
139 work, to write essays for students, and to complete projects for people.
140 The problem with this is that
141 </br>
142 cheating is becoming more universally available and because of this, it can
143 be harder for teacher to
144 </br>
145 separate what has actually been done by the student themselves. Some
146 countries that have banned ChatGPT
147 </br>
148 are Italy, Ukraine, South Sudan, Syria, Chad, Yemen, Afgahanistan, North
149 Korea, Libya, Sudan, Cuba, Iran,
150 </br>
151 Eswatini, Saudi Arabia, Eritrea, China, and Russia. Safeguards like Netskope
152 are implemented to the AI's
153 </br>
154 data loss prevention to sort out what might be sensitive data and keep it
155 safe so that people cannot be
156 </br>
157 hacked through the use of ChatGPT.
